





Q.2: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: The school provides little information about involvement opportunities?















Q.1: How motivating are the classroom lessons at your child's school?




Q.2: To what extent do you think that children enjoy going to your child's school?




Q.1: How well do you feel your child's school is preparing him/her for his/her next academic year?




Q.2: How well do the activities offered at your child's school match his/her interests?

Q.4: At your child's school, how well does the overall approach to discipline work for your child?










Q.5: How comfortable is your child in asking for help from school adults?





Q.1: How often do you worry about violence at your child's school?




Q.3: How likely is it that someone from your child's school will bully him/her online?






